<p>PSED</p> <p>discuss classroom rules and think of good rules for our 'Golden Rules'</p> <p>introduce class bear - send him home with child - Fri</p> <p>Read 'Rainbow fish story' discuss friendship - value</p> <p>Read 'The Good Samaritan' and discuss the morals</p> <p><i>MR- children show sensitivity to others needs and feelings and form positive relationships</i></p> <p><i>SCSA- children are confident to try new activities</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they are confident to speak in a familiar group -they say when they do and don't need to help <p><i>MFB- they adjust their behaviours to different situations</i></p> <p><i>-they know that some behaviour is unacceptable</i></p>			

BI & MFB- plays cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative
