Rationale:

As a school we have a responsibility to provide a broad and balanced curriculum for all pupils. We ensure that we meet the full range of pupil's needs and provide all pupils with challenging work throughout the key stages. Inclusion is embedded in our practice and is reflected in our Special Educational Needs and Disability and Equality Policies.

Aim:

- To give every pupil the opportunity to experience success in learning and achieve as high a standard as is possible
- To ensure work is at an appropriate level taking into account the diverse needs of our community
- For children to have the opportunity to participate in lessons fully and effectively
- For all children to be included in and to have two hours per week of high quality physical education activities
- For all individuals to feel that their contributions are valued
- To foster a tolerant and informed community
- To develop a positive appreciation of differences between ourselves and others
- For all individuals to take responsibility for their behaviour and actions (see behaviour & discipline policy).
- To ensure careful monitoring of each pupil's progress
- To plan opportunities to develop good communication and participation in all aspects of school life.
- To differentiate work to meet the needs of all children
- To ensure appropriate equipment is available to aid inclusion across the curriculum

Practice

Teaching staff are aware of inclusion within the Foundation Stage Curriculum and the National Curriculum and therefore provide effective learning opportunities for all pupils. Teachers are also aware of the requirements of the equal opportunities legislation that covers race, gender and disability.

Success Criteria

- All children will have access to participate in a broad range of activities
- Opportunities will be made available to ensure the inclusion of all pupils through thorough planning.
