<p>Science Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals Compare and group animals according to how and where they live Observe weather changes across the seasons</p>			
<p>Religious Education Special books To look at and talk about books that are special to us To look at and talk about special books from other faiths To talk about why the Bible is a special book To listen and respond to Bible stories</p>
