

Children should...

- Complete as much of their daily work as they are able to.
- Try to complete work on the day that it is set.
- Make sure that they have submitted their work correctly on Google Classroom.
- Check for teacher's comments on completed work and act on any feedback given.
- Feel free to ask any question or tell their teacher anything, by typing a message on any piece of work.



The school will...

- As much as possible, provide a curriculum that mirrors what would be taught in school.
- Provide clear guidance about other daily learning that is expected, e.g. reading, times table practice etc.
- Release work at 5pm for the following day, to allow for different work schedules.
- Provide feedback on work completed within 48 hours of being set.
- Mark any child present in the register if they have completed their daily core learning (English, Maths, Phonics).



Parents can help by...

- Ensuring that their child completes as much of their daily learning as possible.
- Providing a quiet space for children to work.
- Working with their child's teacher to set an alternative work schedule if family circumstances mean that their children is unable to complete all work set daily.
- Communicating with their child's teacher about any illness or changes in home circumstances.
