Health and Safety

Can I please ask parents to help with the following:

- Parents are not to walk through the staff car park gate when dropping off and collecting their children as cars and delivery vans use this entrance and it can be very dangerous. Please use the pedestrian entrance in the alleyway.
- Parents are not to leave children in Year 4 and under unsupervised but must hand them over to a member of staff.
- Can parents of children in KS1 please ensure that when dropping off or collecting their child that they leave the premises promptly to minimise overcrowding at the beginning and end of the school day. Please do not allow your child to play on the climbing equipment or play ball games outside the classrooms. Due to the number of children and adults passing through the area, it is not safe and an incident occurred recently where a member of staff nearly got hit in the face by a ball kicked by a child. Thank you.
